Gas Safe Register will replace CORGI gas registration in Northern Ireland on 1 April 2010. It will be the official hallmark for gas safety.

All Gas Safe registered engineers carry an ID card showing the type of work they are qualified to do. Before any gas work is carried out always make sure you ask to see their Gas Safe Register ID card.

Be safe, know the risks and protect yourself from the dangers of gas.

Poorly maintained, badly installed or faulty gas appliances could put you at risk from gas leaks, fire, explosion and carbon monoxide poisoning. Carbon monoxide is a highly poisonous gas. You can't see it, taste it or smell it, but it can kill quickly with no warning.

Protect yourself:

- make sure your gas appliances are installed, serviced regularly and safety checked every year by a Gas Safe registered engineer
- install an audible carbon monoxide alarm
- know the six main signs and symptoms of carbon monoxide poisoning – headaches, dizziness, nausea, breathlessness, collapse and loss of consciousness
- check the flame is crisp blue and not lazy yellow.

Remember to check both sides of the ID card for:

- the licence number
- the start and expiry date
- the security hologram
- the work your engineer is qualified to do
- up-to-date qualifications.
