The Committee after due adventisement offered by public auction on the sixteenth December last, for setting the Stallages, Kents and Jolls of the several public Markets with the exception of the Hatusia and Market sheet Markets I and of the Staughter House for one year from hist fanuary, one thousand eight hundred and sixty five, when the Committee accepted the Jenous of Mr. Colward Lynch for the Jolls of the Albert Market at Iwo hundred and seventy founds; and of Mr. John Dohenty for the Jolls of the Cathermarket at Jwohundred and fifteen pounds. The Jenous made for the Nictoria, Toyle sheet and Society Sheet Markets and the Haughter House, being considered insufficient, were declined.

Strevious to the Offering of the said Tolls, a Deputation approvided at a Meeting of the Farmers of the Prishict attended and submitted to the Dominittee resolutions passed at the said Meeting, suggesting some changes in the avanagements of the Victoria Market.
