











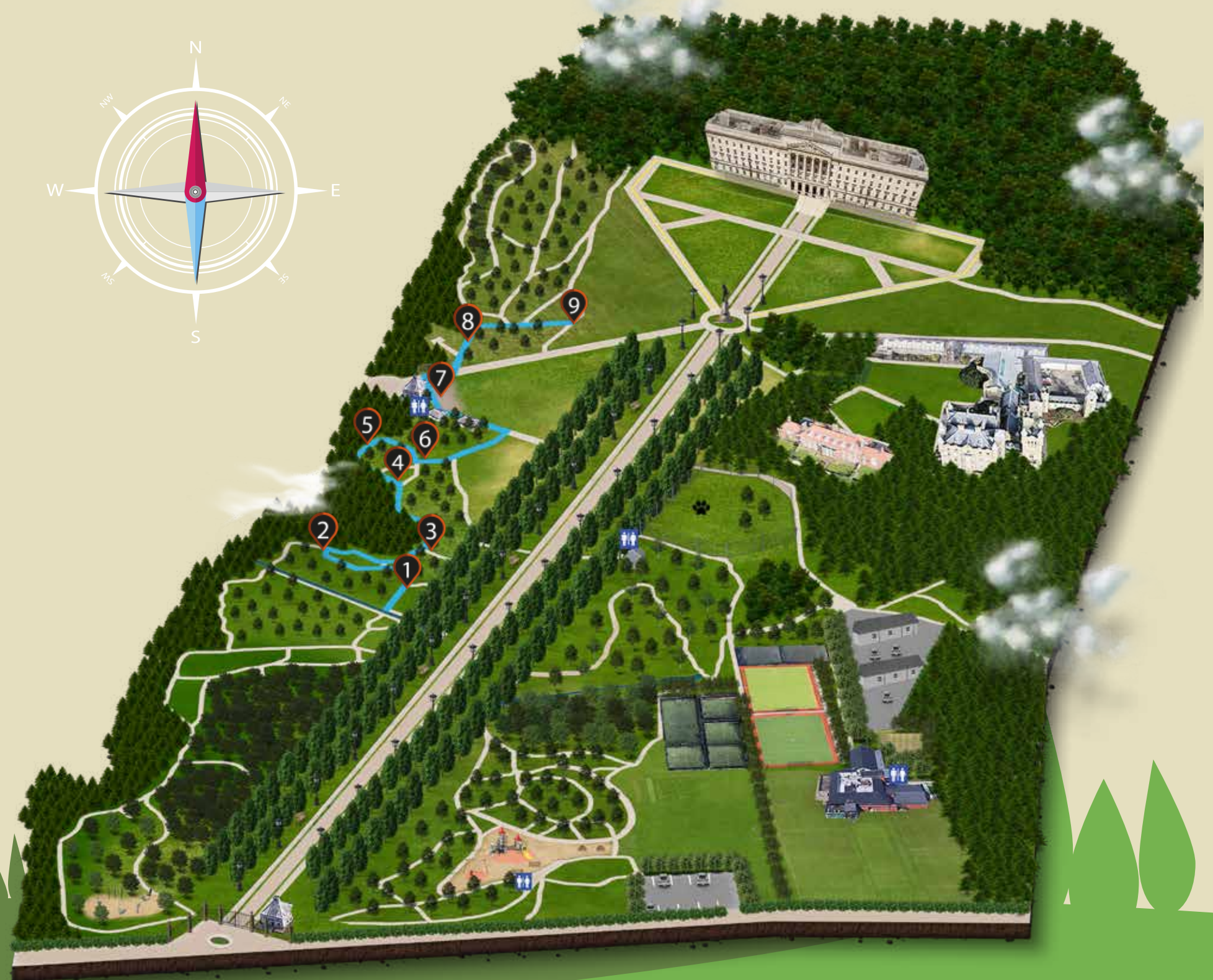
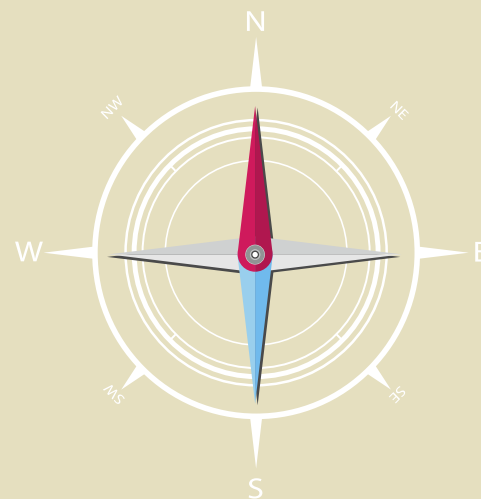

HISTORY TRAIL
