Guidance Notes for Applicants

1. The applicant is required to provide the following information, on the attached form when applying to the Department for consent to undertake the above operations on a public road :-
 - a. Address of the premises where the works are taking place;
 - b. Description where precisely the skip is to be placed;
 - c. The name and permanent address of the applicant;
 - d. The time period on which the skip is to be deposited;
 - e. The details of the owner of the skip.
2. The Department may make regulations specifying conditions subject to which builders' skips may be deposited on roads, and, in particular, conditions relating to—
 - a. the siting of skips,
 - b. the marking on skips of the name and telephone number or address of the owner thereof,
 - c. their dimensions,
 - d. the manner in which they are to be coated with paint or other material for the purpose of making them immediately visible to oncoming traffic,
 - e. the care and disposal of their contents,
 - f. the times at and manner in which they are to be lighted or guarded,
 - g. their removal.
3. The person to whom a consent is issued under this Article in respect of a builder's skip shall indemnify the Department against any claim in respect of injury, damage or loss arising out of the deposit or presence of that skip on a road, other than a claim in respect of injury, damage or loss which is attributable to the negligence of the Department.
4. The applicant shall be responsible for traffic safety and control in accordance with Chapter 8 of the Traffic Signs Manual during the time period stated in application.
